

unemployed





Definition Percentage of the population of a given age



EXPENDITURE ON ALL TYPES OF SOCIAL PROTECTION EXPENDITURE AS A SHARE OF GDP


Budget for expenditures for social protection as a share (%) of Gross Domestic Product (GDP)

Rationale Measures the size of the public support for social protection which is provided to household and individuals affected by a specific set of social risks and needs: disability, sickness/ health care, old age, survivors, family/children, unemployment,

housing and social exclusion


AT THE RISK OF POVERTY RATE (AFTER SOCIAL TRANSFERS)

Definition Proportion of the population that has an income level below the national at-risk-ofpoverty threshold, set at 60 % of the national median equivalised disposable income (after social transfers)

Rationale Informs about the monetary dimension of poverty and social exclusion, i.e. the levels of income below which the population is considered to have relatively low income

Definition The ratio between the median equivalised

disposable income of persons aged 65 or over and the median equivalised disposable income

of persons aged between 0 and 64



COVERAGE OF SOCIAL ASSISTANCE AMONG THE POOREST QUINTILE

Definition Share of the poorest quintile receiving social assistance.

Rationale The indicator measures the effectiveness of social benefits in reducing poverty i.e. if the social protection benefits reach the poor and vulnerable.
